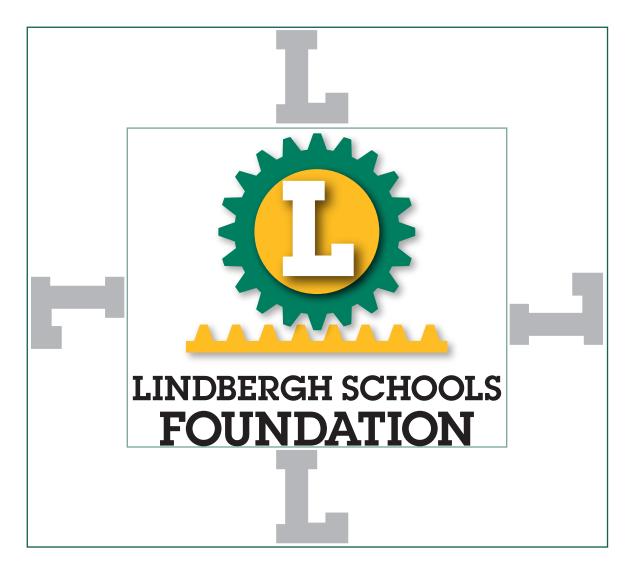
BRAND GUIDELINES

FOUNDATION LOGO

To maintain the visibility and readability of the logo, it is essential to create a defined clear space around it. The purpose of this clear space is to set the logo apart from any other visual elements, such as text or images, which could potentially detract attention from the logo itself.

The extent of this clear space is determined by the height of the uppercase letter "L" in the logo, as indicated in the design guidelines. It is crucial to ensure that no other elements, including graphics, typography, lines, or images, encroach upon this designated clear space.



FOUNDATION PRIMARY LOGOTYPES

These logos serve as the primary choice for all brand communications, playing a pivotal role in facilitating the immediate recognition of the Lindbergh Schools Foundation brand.

The vertical logo holds the position of prominence as the primary logo and should be employed in the majority of cases. In situations where space constraints make it impractical to use the vertical logo, the horizontal version is an alternative option, ensuring the brand's identity remains intact.

FOUNDATION INCORRECT LOGO USEAGE

The Lindbergh Schools Foundation logo must remain unaltered and should not undergo any modifications or edits. Here are some examples of what you should avoid doing:

- Do not stretch width of logo the logo unproportionally.
- Do not codense or distort the logo unproportionally
- Incorrect Usage
- Do not rotate the logo.
- Do not crop the logo
- Do not place remove logo type face and add another word.
- Do not change change font type.
- Do not place logo on top of any image with poor contrast and readability.
- Do not change colors of the logo.

RALEWAY BOLD
